VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION NUMBER (VIN) INVESTIGATION INFORMATION

The Bosque Farms Police Department conducts VIN Investigations by appointment only once a month. Walk-ins are not accepted. All applicants must meet the following qualifications to obtain a VIN Investigation:

- Applicant must possess a valid driver's license
- Applicant must have the ability to bring the vehicle to the Police Department for investigation
- Applicant must possess valid vehicle title or surety bond process paperwork
- The vehicle must be legally owned by applicant and have proof of ownership
- Department will only do Level 2 or 3 VIN Investigation if there is a missing/altered VIN
- No low profile vehicles
- If the VIN appears to have been tampered with, vehicle could be seized
- Department is not responsible for damages that may occur as a result of the VIN Investigation
- Each VIN Investigation is at the discretion of the Investigator
- There is no fee for the inspection, a donation to NM Special Olympics or BFPD Toy Drive is appreciated

A VIN Investigation may take several hours depending on the vehicle. Applicant will have thirty (30) days after the investigation to register the vehicle with NM MVD.
